





"Group of Seven" Macintosh Logic Boards Bare Boards from 1981-1983


The following is the "Group of Seven" Macintosh logic boards from First PCB and First Build in 1982 through the transition from byte-wide to word-wide and thence to the final 512K logic board in 1983. The "Mac man" logo makes its appearance midway through the series. These "bare boards" reside in the private collection of Daniel Kottke who loaned them to the DigiBarn for our [Mac at 20 anniversary online exhibit](#). It doesn't get more rare and more core to the history of the Mac than this folks!




First PCB (1981)


First PCB (reverse)


First Build (1981)




IBM Board (1982)


IBM Board (reverse)


First 512K Board (1982)


First 512K Board (reverse)




SCC Word-Wide (1982)




SCC Word-Wide (reverse)







512K 200-Build (1983)
